Overview and Objectives:

It also discusses other important aspects concerning participation from key constituents: professionals, institutions, and industry and government representatives. ABET is the body empowered to accredit computer science, engineering and technology programs in the United States

of America, and now the rest of the world.

Professor Adnan H. Nayfeh is an international Consultant for Quality and Accreditation

of Higher Education Programs. He is the former president of Zarqa Private University in Jordan and an Emeritus Professor of Engineering from the University of Cincinnati, Ohio, USA. During his thirty years tenure at the University of Cincinnati he was involved in many ABET accreditations. Since his early retirement from UC he has been actively involved in all aspects of quality assurance and accreditation especially for Middle Eastern institutions. To his credit are: his numerous lectures, presentations and workshops on quality education in several area institutions and forums; his leading role in the successful ABET accreditation for the College of Engineering Programs at Qatar University; the successful ABET Accreditation of Engineering, Computer Sciences and Biomedical Programs at King Saud university; his service as a member of three experts on a national accreditation committee in Jordan and his current advising of the College of Computer and Information Technology at King Abdulaziz University and the College of Engineering at Al-Najah University Programs in their preparation for ABET Accreditation.
