

Education has been a national priority for Egypt over the past few years, and it continues to be an integral part of the government's development plan. Technical and Vocational Education and Training (TVET) is at the heart of the new education reform. The Ministry of Education's strategy is an innovative reform program aimed at transforming technical education and the development of the different sectors of TVET into one of the important axes of preparation for the Fourth Industrial Revolution and for the implementation of the sustainable development plan of Egypt.





Vision and Key Pillars of Technical Education Transformation in Egypt

Pillar 1 - Improving the quality of technical education (the establishment of the Egyptian Authority for Quality Assurance and Accreditation in Technical and Technical Education and Vocational Training (ETQAAN) and the Quality Support Centre for Technical Education Schools (CEQAT)).

Pillar 2 – Transforming curricula into curricula based on the skills methodology + digitizing educational content and introducing blended learning systems (skills + competencies + digitalization).

Pillar 3 – Improving the skills of teachers through training and qualification (establishing an academy for technical education teachers 'TVETA').

Pillar 4 - Employer participation in the development of technical education) Applied technology schools, dual education schools, and sectoral skills councils.

Pillar 5 - Changing the stereotypical image of technical education.



Over the past three years, EDUGATE has successfully organized "EduTech "annual forums in 2022, 2023, and 2024. 

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
