Announcement of the Winners of the Association of Arab Universities Award for Best PhD Thesis and Master's Thesis for 2025

The winners of the Association of Arab Universities Award for Best PhD Thesis and Master's Thesis for 2025 have been announced, with several distinguished researchers from various Arab countries being honored.

In the field of basic and applied sciences, Dr. Hadeel bint Mohammed bin Abdullah Al-Fawzan from Qassim University in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia won the Best PhD Thesis Award for her research on the use of modern digital technology to achieve sustainable development goals in the field of green economy and its impact on human health.

In the field of Master's Thesis, the award was granted to researcher Omnia El-Sayed from Cairo University in Egypt and researcher Dina Nimer Agha from Nineveh University in Iraq.

In the field of humanities and social sciences, Dr. Ikram Al-Hanaiya from the World Islamic Sciences University in Jordan won the Best PhD Thesis Award for her research on mental health and its impact on Arab society. As for the Master's Thesis, researcher Batoul Mohammed Matar from Birzeit University in Palestine received the award.

Several distinguished researchers were honored across different categories. In the Circular Economy category, Professor Dr. Heba Salah Hamed from Ain Shams University, Egypt, was awarded the first prize, valued at \$15,000, for her outstanding contribution to the field.

In the Renewable Energy category, the first prize of \$15,000 was jointly awarded to Professor Dr. Maher Maher Al-Jaabari and researchers

Raghad Mubarak and Dana Al-Jabari from Palestine Polytechnic University. The second prize, valued at \$7,500, went to researchers Mohamed Nasser Nafea and Hamdy Hassan from Zagazig University, Egypt, for their notable research project.



Association of Arab Universities Signs Memorandum of Understanding with Qistas to Advance Digital Legal Education



The Association of Arab Universities has signed a Memorandum of Understanding with CyberLaw/Qistas for Information Technology at the association's headquarters in the Jordanian capital, Amman. The aim of the agreement is to strengthen collaboration in the fields of law and legal technology and to develop legal education in Arab universities in alignment with the evolving demands of the modern job market.

The MoU was signed on behalf of the Association of Arab Universities by H.E. Professor Dr. Amr Ezzat

Salama, Secretary-General of the Association, and on behalf of CyberLaw by Ms. Nasreen Haram, the company's Executive Director. The agreement seeks to unify efforts between the two parties across several areas, including organizing scientific conferences and workshops, developing joint training programs for students and faculty members, producing practical course materials that complement theoretical curricula, and emphasizing the use of artificial intelligence tools and digital legal research.

During the signing ceremony, both parties reaffirmed their commitment to exchanging scientific and practical expertise and to forming joint working teams to activate and follow up on the implementation of the agreement's provisions.

This initiative comes as part of the association's ongoing commitment to achieving its strategic goals (2019–2030), particularly in the areas of enhancing education quality, managing and producing knowledge, and aligning higher education outcomes with labor market needs, especially within the rapidly evolving legal sector.





Strategic Meeting Between the Association of Arab Universities and AACSB to Advance Business Education in the Arab World



On the sidelines of the AACSB International Conference and Annual Meeting (ICAM 2025), held in Vienna from 7–9 April 2025, a high-level strategic meeting was held to advance cooperation between the Association of Arab Universities and AACSB International.

The meeting brought together Ms. Lily Bi, President and CEO of AACSB; Dr. Geoff Perry, Executive Vice President and Managing Director for Asia Pacific; Prof. Eileen McAuliffe, Executive Vice President and Managing Director for Europe, Middle East, and Africa; and Mr. Ihsan Zakri, Vice President for Europe, Middle East, and Africa. The Association of Arab Universities was represented by Professor Dr. Anas Alsoud, Executive Director of the Association.

This meeting follows the landmark

partnership agreement signed in January 2025 by His Excellency Professor Amr Salama, Secretary General of the Association of Arab Universities, and Ms. Lily Bi, President and CEO of AACSB. The discussion focused on the implementation of a joint action plan to support Arab business schools in their journey toward achieving AACSB accreditation. The partnership aims to enhance the quality, impact, and global recognition of business education across the Arab world, in alignment with international standards of excellence.

This collaboration reflects a shared commitment to fostering academic innovation, institutional development, and sustainable growth in higher education across the region.

The Association of Arab Universities Explores Avenues of Cooperation with the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research in Tunisia



As part of its efforts to strengthen Arab academic collaboration, His Excellency Mr. Mondher Belhadj, Minister of Higher Education and Scientific Research of the Republic of Tunisia, received on Monday, April 15, 2025, a delegation from the Association of Arab Universities (AAU), headed by His Excellency Prof. Dr. Amr Ezzat Salama, Secretary-General of the Association. He was accompanied by Prof. Dr. Anas Alsoud, Executive Director of the Association, and Ms. Lina Al-Bitar, Director of the General Administration. The meeting took place at the Ministry's headquarters in the capital, Tunis, in the presence of several senior ministry officials. During the meeting, His Excellency the Minister praised the vital role played by the Association of Arab Universities in supporting the higher education system across the Arab world. He commended the

Association's strategic initiatives and its impactful projects, as well as the active participation of Tunisian universities in its activities.

For his part, the Secretary-General presented an overview of the Association's key programs and initiatives, including the Arab University Ranking project, academic accreditation initiatives, and programs focused on quality assurance and research development.

The discussions also addressed ways to enhance the engagement of Tunisian universities within the various structures of the Association and to establish strategic partnerships within the framework of Arab joint academic cooperation, while also expanding connections with regional and international academic networks. These efforts aim to further support the quality of higher education in Tunisia and the broader Arab region.

AARU and MUBS organized a scientific conference titled "Social Work: Between Reality and Rights"



The Social Service Association of the Association of Arab Universities, in collaboration with the Department of Social Work at the Modern University for Business and Science (MUBS), organized a scientific conference titled "Social Work: Between Reality and Rights" on the occasion of the Global Month for Social Work. The conference was held on Thursday, March 27, 2025, at the Badaro branch.

The conference was distinguished by the presence of a group of experts and practitioners in the field, including Ms. Sahira Mataweh, Secretary-General of the community service Association of the Association of Arab Universities, along with active participation from civil society organizations, academics, and students.

The conference activities began with a welcoming speech to the attendees, followed by a speech from Dr. Hatem Allameh, Chairman of the Board of Trustees of the University, who emphasized the pivotal role of social work in achieving sustainable community development. He stressed that child protection and women's empowerment should be top priorities in social policies, as they represent a fundamental pillar for a fairer and more stable future.

This was followed by a speech from Professor Amal Hawari, Head of the Department of Social Work, who opened by paying tribute and respect to every social work specialist on the occasion of World Social Work Day. She affirmed that their efforts form the essential backbone of building a stronger society. Hawari also highlighted the need to develop modern strategies to address the challenges facing children and women and to enhance the role of social work professionals in this context.


Professor Amal Hawari moderated the first session, titled "Childhood Between Safety and Risks – The Gap of Protection and Responsibility", during which Judge Fatima Majed discussed the mechanisms for the legal protection of children in Lebanon. Professor Taghreed Al-Abdallah presented the role of international organizations in supporting at-risk children, while Professor Charlotte Tanios offered insights into the challenges facing protection programs and the ways to develop them.

The second session, titled "Women Between Rights and Vulnerability – The Dialectics of Empowerment and Reality", was moderated by Professor

Talal Malaeb. Professor Rajwa Fitroni discussed community initiatives supporting women's rights, Dr. Sanaa Nimer provided an analysis of the gap between legislation and practical implementation, and Professor Charlotte Khalil spoke about the psychological aspects and challenges faced by women in unstable environments.

The conference concluded with a set of recommendations stressing the need to strengthen laws concerning child protection and women's empowerment and to activate the mechanisms for their implementation. It also called for expanding cooperation between academic institutions and social organizations, developing training programs to better equip social work professionals with more effective tools, and integrating social work strategies into sustainable development plans to ensure broader and more lasting impact.

The conference reflected the commitment of the Modern University for Business and Science and its partners to fostering scientific dialogue on urgent social issues and provided an ideal platform for exchanging ideas and solutions between academics and practitioners. We look forward to more fruitful initiatives in the future!





Launch of the "Certified Assessor Program" with Wide Arab Participation to Enhance Evaluation Quality in Higher Education

The opening session witnessed





He pointed out that the Association of Arab Universities pays great attention to building the capacities of faculty members and enhancing their competencies in evaluation fields to ensure high-quality educational outcomes. He also praised the ongoing partnership among Arab universities and the leading role of the Scientific Association for Measurement and Evaluation in designing and implementing this ambitious program.

Professor Dr. Amani Osama Kamel, Vice President of Ain Shams University for Postgraduate Studies and Research, highlighted the university's continuous support for developing the competencies of faculty members and its keen interest in strengthening regional partnerships that serve

educational and research processes. She also commended the efforts of the Scientific Association for Measurement and Evaluation, affirming that the program fills a real gap in specialized evaluation training, which is a fundamental pillar for academic accreditation and quality assurance in education.

In his speech, Professor Dr. Nidal Aisheh, Vice President of Zarqa University for Administrative Affairs, praised the ongoing collaboration between Zarqa University (Jordan) and Ain Shams University, which was crowned with a strategic partnership agreement signed in May 2024 during the annual conference of Ain Shams University. It has been carefully designed to offer advanced, comprehensive training content covering the most important academic evaluation topics — from designing educational objectives to analyzing and evaluating learning outcomes and applying academic accreditation standards — including designing diverse and effective assessment tools, using digital technologies and artificial intelligence in evaluation, and ethical frameworks for evaluation practices. She added that participants would gain practical experiences and specialized skills that qualify them to become leaders in evaluation and quality assurance within their educational institutions.

It is worth mentioning that the program extends over 8 weeks, with two sessions per week, totaling 48 training hours, in addition to asynchronous activities through a Learning Management System (LMS). It includes the participation of 25 trainees from various disciplines, including 20 trainees from Zarqa University, under the supervision of Professor Dr. Reda Al-Muwaadhiya, Dean of the College of Education and

Director of the Development and Quality Assurance Unit at Zarqa University.


